Council notes:

That a report by amnesty international in February 2022 concluded that system of oppression and domination in Israel amount to apartheid.

Council also notes:

That the conflict in Gaza has seen in recent months an unprecedent loss of life to those

living in the Gaza region. This conflict has led to the death of over 11,000 people and over

400 of those who have died were members of the higher education community and that 11

higher education buildings were completely or partially destroyed.

Council notes with great concern:

That the conflict is Gaza is currently not the only humanitarian crisis occurring across the

world, such as the events occurring in but not limited to Ukraine, Yemen and Syria.

Council Believes:

That if TUS SU adopt an anti-war and expansionism position it would be effective in mobilising members to stand in solidarity with the Irish student movement and the Union of Students in Ireland to unify as one voice.

Council therefore mandates:

TUS SU to endorse the BDS movement by taking part in their campaign and providing

members of TUS SU with information on the BDS movement and TUS SU involvement in the movement where possible. This includes but is not limited to; promoting local protests depending on the region of the University.

Council Further Mandates:

TUS SU to adopt an Anti-war and expansionism position where possible.
