Use of Irish in TUS SU/ AML OTS

Council Notes: That the Irish language is the official language of the Irish state.

Council further notes that: Many unions now use the Irish for terms such as Student Council Executive Team, Working Groups etc.

Council Recognises: That union up and down the country now operate using their name in a bilingual manner USI/AMLÉ, TCDSU/AMLCT, UOGSU/CMLOG UCCSU/AMLCOC etc.

Council Therefore mandates: For the Union Executive to use the Irish language when referencing to internal committees, working groups the union and other union related terms and activities where possible. A list will be provided to the executive and Student council each year with the translation of each of the group names.

Council further mandates: The executive team to use both TUS SU and AMLOTS when referring to the union in their work where possible.

Council further mandates: The Union where possible will implement the use of bilingual signage in union spaces.

Council further mandates: That when completing the next Constitutional referendum, The Executive must deliberate adding in additions for the Irish language in the constitution.
